Add Hardware.



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To add a Hardware

- Open Add Hardware in Control Panel.
- In the add Hardware Wizard, click Next.
- Click Add a New Hardware device, and then click Next.
- Do one of the following:
 - Click Search for and install the hardware automatically (Recommended) if you want windows to try to detect the new non-Plug and Play device you want to install.

To add a Hardware

 Click Install the Hardware that I manually select from a list (Advanced) if you know the type and model of the device you are installing and you want to selec

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- Insert the Software CD in the CD drive.
- Usually as soon as the computer reads the CD it starts the installation on its own due to a file called Autorun.
- If not, then right click on the CD drive icon and select the open option.
- Search for an icon named Setup.

- Click the Setup icon to run the Setup which would start the installation.
- In some cases you will be asked for the CD key/Serial. [A CD key/Serial is a unique key of combination of numbers and letters. Its like the CD password. Its used for security purposes].
- CD key can be found in a file called CD key/Serial, which is in the CD.

- Right click on the CD Drive and select the open option.
- The CD files would open. Search for the CD key/Serial file and note the CD key/Serial. [Note the key before starting the installation].
- Provide the number to the installation process when asked and follow the instructions of the installation wizard.

To Add a program from a CD or a Pen Drive

- Open Add or remove Programs in Control Panel.
- Click Add New Programs, and then click CD or Pen Drive.
- Follow the instructions on your screen.

<u>To Add a program from a CD or a Pen</u> <u>Drive</u>

Note:

- To open Add or Remove Programs, click Start, point to settings, click Control Panel, and then double click Add or Remove Programs.
- When using Add or Remove Programs, you can only install programs that were written for windows operating systems

To remove a software

- Go to Control Panel and Right click on the Add or Remove Programs option.
- The Add or Remove Programs dialog box appears on the screen.
- From the list of programs select the program you wish to remove.

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How To Create Image File

- Double click on Nero Software.
- A Nero window will open on your screen.
- Then select Make Data Disk Option.
- Click on Add button.

How To Create Image File

- Select the desired Software location which image file you want to create.
- Click on Next button.
- Select Image Recorder from Current Recorder.
- Click on Burn button.

<u>How To Create Image File</u>

- Then a Save Image File dialog box will open then specify the path where you want to save your file.
- After this a Confirmation Dialog Box will appear.
- Then click on Ok button, then Click on Next button.
- Last click on Exit Button.

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
Mount Image

- This option enables users to mount an image file that is stored in the hard disk to a virtual CD/DVD-ROM.
- This mounting action is just as the same as loading a CD or DVD into a real CD/DVD-ROM drive.

How To Mount Image

- First click on Alcohol 120%.
- An Alcohol 120% -Trial Version window will appear.
- Then Right Click on Virtual Drive, and select Mount Image option.
- Select Image Location, then click on Open button.

- A Virtual Drive Window will appear.
- Then Double Click on Setup File.
- Follow the instructions on your screen.




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<u>Unmount Image</u>

- This option enables users to Unmount an image file from the virtual CD/DVD-ROM.
- This Unmounting action is considered as unloading the CD/DVD from the real CD/DVD-ROM Drive.

<u>How To Unmount Image</u>

- First click on Alcohol 120%.
- An Alcohol 120% -Trial Version window will appear.
- Then Right Click on Virtual Drive, and select Unmount image option.


